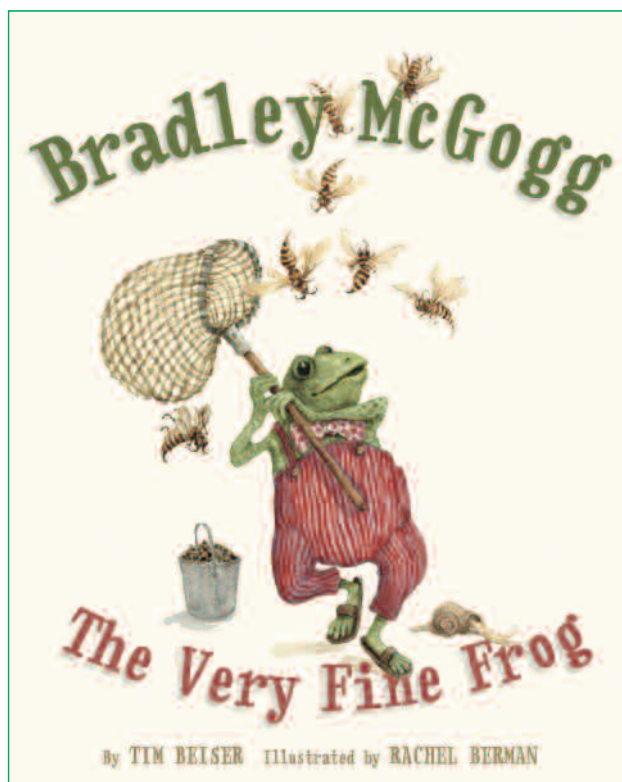
# Bradley McGogg, the Very Fine Frog

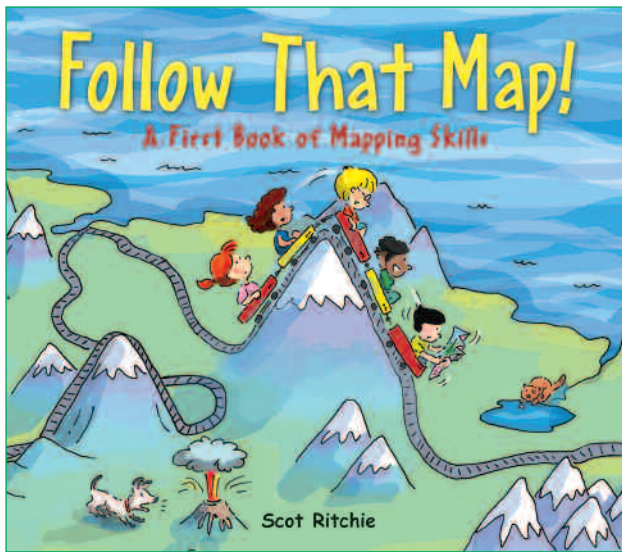
